Coach

A Coach at Fast Camp will work with campers between the age of 6 to 13 each day, actively participating in games/sports/activities with the campers while monitoring and supervising them, leading by example and using appropriate discipline techniques when required. This position is responsible for helping to maintain a safe, clean summer program site; ensuring a high level of program quality; and working to establish a positive impact with all campers and their families. The Coach is a positive role model to campers. Coaches must have high energy, self-motivation, and enthusiasm.

Program Director Qualities

- Ability to work with children between the age of 6 to 13
- Knowledge of camp programs and planning
- Ability to always promote safety and well-being of campers
- Experience / desire to work with children
- Enthusiastic, Responsible, Dependable, Level-Headed, Flexible, and Calm in all situations

Duties and Responsibilities

In coordination with the Head Coach:

- Ensure safety of all participants at all times specifically responsible for the health and safety of their camp roster.
- Work collaboratively with Head Coach to ensure all campers are safe and having a good time.
- Foster a positive and inclusive camp environment where campers feel safe, supported, and encouraged to participate. Assist those campers who may need help fitting into the camp atmosphere.

- Help ensure morale of campers by monitoring rest, eating habits, and balance of activities.
- Facilitate age-appropriate activities
- Ensure children apply sunscreen and hydrate throughout the day
- Assist with all assigned aspects of the campers' day including activities, specialty activities, cleanup, meal/snack time, and camper personal belongings.
- Facilitate campers in emergency procedures such as fire drills, evacuating buildings, severe weather warnings, etc.
- All staff should possess respect for others, punctuality, cleanliness, appropriate clothing, ownership in camp properties/equipment and programs, good sportsmanship, etc.
- Report to Head Coach or Camp Director any guest, volunteer, or site problems that you are not able to resolve on your own as soon as possible.

Qualifications

- Must be 16 years of age
- Must be willing to play with children for a minimum of 8 hours per day

Physical Requirements

- Some lifting and carrying required of objects up to 50 lbs
- Regular standing and/or walking, along with the need to bend, reach and kneel
